Tam Bronkey: PGA Director of Instruction

Tam Bronkey has given quality golf instruction for nearly 20 years and has been instructing golfers at Eagle Crest for 4 years after previously working in the Southern California Section of the PGA. Tam's students enjoy his friendly approach, use of state of the art motion analysis video technology, and comprehensive teaching style. Tam is an accomplished player as a graduate of and former University of Oregon varsity team member, a current course record holder at 2 courses, and played on the PGA Tour as a qualifier in the Northern Trust L.A. Tam is an active instructor in the community as he teaches credit classes for Central Oregon Community College and serves as Swing Coach for the Redmond High School Girls team.
